OBJECTIVES

The 2009 meeting of the Midwest Sport & Exercise Psychology Symposium is designed to:

- Enhance the scientific and professional understanding of psychological factors associated with sport and exercise in non-clinical and clinical populations;
- Provide a forum for students to present research related to sport and exercise psychology;
- Promote interaction among researchers, professionals, and students to provide new approaches to, and perspectives on, issues related to sport and exercise psychology.
