

Source Data - Claims link with Medical Mutual (TS+DJW)

Data ran as of July 29, 2008

Numbers will change in September based on termination of coverage for faculty who retired or left the university and new faculty hires with coverage begin date of 9-1-0

Note: Eligible dependent children who are unmarried and primarily dependent upon employee for support due to physical handicap or mental retardation and unable to work due to incapacity are covered beyond the age limit as long as the incapacity was started before the age limit was reached and require: medical certification and yearly proof that incapacity continues

Data requested to answer questions as noted below

1. How many dependents are covered between ages 19 and 23?
2. How many dependents at age 19 that may lose coverage if not full time student as of January 1, 2009?
3. How many dependents at age 23 in 2008 who will lose coverage effective January 1, 2009?
4. Using the 50% assumption- How many dependents who turn 23 in 2008 may be a full time student who may or could be covered in 2009 through end of the calendar year they obtain 24

Assumptions

1. 50% of dependents between ages of 19 and 23 are not full time students
