

DRIVER INSURABILITY POLICY

Bowling Green State University requires that all employees (*faculty, administrative and classified staff*) who operate state vehicles be eligible for coverage by the university's insurance provider. The purpose of this policy is to minimize the liability that high-risk drivers can cause as well as provide a safe working environment for the students, faculty, staff and visitors. Current employees must maintain a driving record that meets the insurance carrier's criteria. Violations which may affect an employee's insurability include driving under the influence, hit and run, negligent homicide by use of a vehicle, operating a vehicle while under suspension or revocation, reckless operation, etc.

University employees and off-campus applicants who apply for a position that will entail driving a state vehicle must sign a statement authorizing the university to conduct a driver record check with the Ohio Bureau of Motor Vehicles.

Additional details on the Driver Insurability Policy may be found in the Administrative Staff Handbook and the Classified Staff Handbook. There is no information on this policy in the Charter's Faculty Handbook although the policy does apply to faculty.

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
