

## ***TOLEDO INDUSTRIAL RECREATION AND EMPLOYEE SERVICES (T.I.R.E.S) POLICY***

The Toledo Industrial Recreation and Employee Services Council (T.I.R.E.S.) is a non-profit association of management representatives from leading Toledo and surrounding area businesses, academia, industry, government and community service organizations. The Council was established to promote services and recreational programs for employees, to promote the exchange of ideas and administrative expertise, and to provide discounted member services. Bowling Green State University is a member of this organization, and as such, all faculty and staff are eligible for special rates or discounts on products and services that T.I.R.E.S. member institutions have to offer.
