Also of interest are issues involving the education, training, and certification of professionals.

Health Psychology

Focusing on research, theory, and intervention that address the relationship between mental and physical health. This area's emphasis is on the role of psychological factors in sport and exercise, particularly as they relate to disease development and remediation, coping skills, and health promotion.

Social Psychology

Focusing on research, theory, and intervention that address individual and group processes in sport and exercise settings. Of particular interest is the interaction of individual and situational factors, and its effect on participation and performance in sport and exercise.
