

Landmark building isn't 'round anymore



Saddlemire Student Services Building was torn down to make room for the future Wolfe Center for the Arts. Demolition of the 40-year-old campus landmark—commonly called “the round building”—began in late July. About 75 percent of the building was recycled. Many of the offices formerly located in Saddlemire moved to Conklin North. Construction of the Wolfe Center will likely begin in 2008. The construction time frame for the new arts center is about two years; a new student services building is still a few years away.
