Scholarship Information

AIMS has three scholarship programs – AIMS Standard, AIMS-BOSEF and AIMS GRAMS that range from \$1500 with annual incremental increases to \$10,000 for students with unmet financial need.

Criteria

3.0+ GPA and 20+ ACT with a major in Science, Technology, Math and Computer Science or other STEM related fields. Please note that additional criteria may be required for the AIMS BOSEF and AIMS GRAMS scholarship programs.
