Thanks for your interest in the Academic Investment in Mathematics and Science (AIMS) program. The goal of the AIMS program is to encourage women and students of color to graduate from BGSU with majors in mathematics, computer and natural sciences. AIMS students have the unique opportunity to strengthen their academic skills and to increase their likelihood for academic success at BGSU. Also, they will develop professional and leadership skills required for advancement in mathematics and the sciences as future researchers and teachers (elementary, secondary and/or college level). AIMS awardees will minimally receive a \$1500 scholarship-- renewable for 3 years. For those who qualify other financial assistance may be available.

The Academic Investment in Mathematics and Science (AIMS) program requires study leading to a bachelor's degree in mathematics, computer and natural science fields or teacher education with majors in these areas. Students should plan to enroll (or have previously completed) AIMS Seminar, course A&S 100.

Please complete all sections of the enclosed AIMS application. A minimum transfer GPA of 3.0 or a BGSU college GPA of 2.85 on a 4 point scale is required to qualify for the program. Additionally, for transfer students a complete Undergraduate Application of Admission to Bowling Green State University (BGSU) **must** be on file with the Office of Admissions before your AIMS application can be processed. You can obtain a BGSU application from the BGSU Office of Admissions or from the admissions website at www.bgsu.edu/offices/admissions.

All sections of the completed AIMS Award Application must be received in the AIMS office by March 1, 2009. Please indicate to your references (at least one of those must be from a college math/science instructor) that recommendation letters should be sent directly to Dr. T. Carter Gilmer.
