



## Application Checklist

---

All of the following items are needed to complete your Honors Program application. Incomplete applications will not be evaluated. You may send materials in separately or all together.

### Needed:

- Honors Program Application for Admission.
  - High school transcript(s). **A separate one from the one you sent to Admissions is required.**
  - Application Response (100 words or less): Describe your long term academic and career goals and how the Honors Program will help you achieve those goals.
  - Critical Thinking Essay (Typical response is 250 to 500 words): Pick one of the current national or international news editorials provided to you by the Honors Program. Write a response to the news editorial about the biases the author possesses. For instance, if the author seems to be biased in any way, or omits any important information, make sure you mention it in your essay.
  - All pieces of the application must be sent to: Honors Program, BGSU, 209E Harshman, 125 N. Mercer Rd., Bowling Green, OH 43403-0229.

**Please note:** You need not wait for your acceptance into the Honors Program to sign up for the Honors Learning Community in Harshman Dunbar.
