Frequently Asked Questions

Why does the Honors Learning Community offer trips?

These trips are great opportunities for you to make intellectual and social connections outside of the classroom. Plus, they are a lot of fun!

How many trips may I go on each year?

You may choose one overnight trip but are welcome to attend any day trips. Remember, space is limited for day trips so reserve your spot early.

How much do the trips cost?

Your Honors Learning Community fee covers the bulk of the cost! You may need to bring money for food, gifts, and certain attractions on some trips.

What is the cancellation policy?

Because space is limited, you must make cancellations before the trip. If you fail to cancel before the cancellation deadline, you forfeit your deposit. For cancellations made after the cancellation deadline, refunds will ONLY be made when another HLC student is willing to switch places.

If I do not go on any trips, will I get a refund?

No. HLC members who do not participate in these optional day or overnight trips will not receive a fee refund... so take advantage of the opportunity!
