



Greek Academic Incentives Fund Policy

Scholarship is one of the four founding principles of all fraternities and sororities (leadership, service and brotherhood/sisterhood being the other three). To demonstrate support for this founding principle, Residence Life/Greek Affairs established an Academic Incentives Fund to reward those chapters that do well academically each semester. Below is an outline of how this program works each semester.

The Academic Incentive Program for Greek Chapters is as follows:

- a. Incentive dollars available each semester are \$7,500 (\$15,000 annually)
- b. Fraternities with a GPA above either the All-Mens Undergrad or All-Fraternity G.P.A (whichever is higher); and sororities with a GPA above either the All-Womens Undergrad or All-Sorority G.P.A (again, whichever is higher) may split the \$7,500. This is to ensure that both men and women have an equal opportunity to receive these incentives.
- c. All incentives must be used toward improving your chapters facilities and approved by Greek Affairs

We hope this fund provides sufficient incentives for our housed fraternities and sororities to maintain high academic standards each semester.
