Greek Leadership Programs

GREEK LIFE EXPERIENCE BRINGS LEADERSHIP TRAINING

Greek Affairs is fortunate to provide a comprehensive leadership program for our 1,800 fraternity and sorority members that encompasses new member programs, emerging leader programs, retreats for officers and two credit classes. Our goal remains the same for all that we offer: to provide our Greek leaders with the leadership tools necessary to continually improve the Greek Community.

This fall, we held three major leadership events: the Fall Leadership Retreat, Greek Odyssey, and Emerging Leaders. The annual Fall Leadership Retreat was for chapter presidents, recruitment chairs, and scholarship chairs, as well as the four council executive councils and cabinets in order to assist as many Greek leaders as possible to prepare for the upcoming year. In all, over 100 student leaders attended the retreat.

In late October, all individuals who joined a fraternity or sorority in Fall 2006 attended BGSU's new member leadership program, Greek Odyssey. Attendees learned about the Greek community at BGSU while interacting with other new Greek students.

Our longest running leadership program, Emerging Leaders, was held in early November. Emerging Leaders is a weekend retreat for up-and-coming Greek leaders. It is our most prominent leadership program and one that many future Greek leaders attend.

This spring, we had a busy semester of leadership events as well. In early January, we held our annual January Leadership Retreat at the Wyndham Hotel in Toledo. This overnight event for chapter presidents and council executive officers was again

successful this year, as the Greek leaders were educated on important issues in the Greek community here at BGSU. Because many of the chapters and councils sent newly elected officers, it was a great opportunity for all attendees to meet new people and connect with old friends.

February was very busy, with three leadership programs occurring over the course of the month. February 3 was Leadership Academy, which is a half-day leadership conference for all student leaders at BGSU. Greek Affairs co-sponsored this event with the Office of Residence Life and the Office of Campus Involvement. Greek Odyssey once again took place in February for all new members of the Greek

community who joined in Spring 2007. Finally, there was a reunion for all student leaders who attended Emerging Leaders in November.

The Greek Leadership coordinates many of these programs and recently finished the application process for the 2007-2008 academic year. They met after spring break to transition into their new positions.

Finally, Greek Affairs offers two leadership courses that students can take for credit: UNIV 210 and UNIV 310. The first course is the starter course that many Greek student leaders enroll in and that our Greek Leadership Team students also take. This course provides the basics in leadership. The second course, UNIV 310, is an advanced leadership course for Greeks. This Spring this course was offered to a fraternity and a sorority executive board to focus on a specific project to improve their chapter.

Overall, there were many opportunities for our members to learn more about leadership to improve their chapters and councils. Fraternities and sororities remain one of the finest leadership laboratories ever created.

Over the past semester the Greek Independent Board has seen continual growth and improvement in its six chapters. Another focus of our group is to collaborate, not only within the Greek Independent Board chapters, but all the other Greeks on campus as well. We are committed to providing guidance and resources to each of our groups and helping them to learn from each other. With an additional executive board member, and a possible new group coming to GIB, we are looking forward to a very successful spring semester.
