Spring 2007 Greek Report Executive Summary

This report is sent to all BGSU Faculty/Staff to inform them about the BGSU Greek Community. On the reverse side is the statistical report for Fall 2006.

Scholarship

- The Greek GPA was above the non-Greek GPA (2.88 vs. 2.86).
- The average undergraduate fraternity and sorority ACT score was 21.8, with the average undergraduate ACT score being 21.9
- Eight groups fell below the 2.50 GPA minimum and will not have social privileges for Fall.
- \$10,667 or \$6/Greek member were provided by chapters to reward their members for good scholarship.
- Gamma Sigma Alpha – National Greek Academic Honor Society inducted 30 members (jr. or sr. status and a 3.5 cumulative GPA for membership).

Recruitment & Retention

- 206 students joined fraternities and sororities Spring (569 joined Fall, 775 for the year): 86 women joined the 14 Panhellenic sororities, 65 men joined the 15 IFC fraternities, 28 joined the seven National Pan-Hellenic (NPHC) groups through the “intake” process, and 27 joined the six GIB groups.
- 92% of new members persisted in their group through the end of the semester, indicating students and chapters made good choices.
- 89% of first-year Greek students were retained to their second year, compared to 74% for the campus.

Service & Philanthropy

- 26,776 hours, or 15/Greek member, of hands-on community service was performed by Greeks for Fall.
- \$46,806, or \$27/Greek member, was raised for philanthropy by Greeks for Fall.

Leadership & Involvement

- 47%, or 822 members, of the Greek Community were involved in other BGSU student groups.
- Order of Omega – National Greek Leadership Honor Society inducted 20 members (jr. or sr. status, 3.0 GPA and extensive leadership).
- The Greek Leadership Program includes a new member program, emerging leaders program, a President’s retreat and two courses for credit.

Advisors, Parents & Alumni

- All chapters have an advisor who works closely with the chapter and officers, and are copied on all Greek Affairs correspondence.
- Parents receive a four-page newsletter each semester that includes many updates including latest Greek Report.
- 22,000 BGSU Greek Alumni receive a semesterly e-newsletter that includes updates about the Greek Community and the latest Greek Report.

Housing

- 550 Greeks are housed in 32 houses or residence halls owned by BGSU, with a live-in graduate staff member who is supervised by Greek Affairs.

Discipline

- Five chapters were found responsible for violating either BGSU or Greek Council policies Fall: Alpha Xi Delta sorority (drinking in the chapter house), Kappa Kappa Gamma sorority (inappropriate t-shirt), Phi Delta Theta fraternity (failure to sanction an individual member), Sigma Phi Epsilon fraternity (inappropriate t-shirt) and Phi Kappa Tau fraternity (failure to comply with an IFC sanction). All were placed on probation with other penalties such as restitution, apologizing and social privileges being taken away.
