ENTRY FEE: \$10.00/TEAM – Payment must be submitted no later than 48 hours after registering your team on www.bgsu.imleagues.com. Failure to do so will result in the team being dropped from the league. Check, Cash or Credit cards will be accepted as forms of payment.

ENTRIES ACCEPTED: Beginning Wednesday, August 27 through Tuesday, September 2, entries will be accepted on a first come, first served basis, and may be submitted in the following manner:

- 1) Log onto www.bgsu.imleagues.com, by **11:55 p.m.** on due date to register for a league. Create an account using your **BGSU** email address. A password will be sent to that email address for you to log on.
- 2) Once completely logged in, imleagues.com will ask if you want to join BGSU intramurals. Click on join. This will bring you to the BGSU Intramural homepage. Remember you also have your OWN homepage as well. Make sure to check both home pages for updates daily.
- 3) To Register: Go to BGSU homepage at bgsu.imleagues.com. Click on the icon of the sport you wish to register for and follow on screen instructions.

ENTRY NOTES: Fraternities and Sororities may only enter one team in the Greek division. Other players may enter the independent division. Must have player's correct name and PID# or player will be dropped. Teams needing players or individuals wanting to join a team should check the web or call the office for "free agent" information.

FORFEITS: Forfeits occurring during regular season will count as a contest loss and may have an adverse effect on your team qualifying for playoffs. A second forfeit during the season drops a team from all further play. No forfeits fees will be assessed this academic year.

CAPTAINS RESPONSIBILITIES: In lieu of attendance at a pre-season captain's meeting, each team captain must read and acknowledge their understanding of the expectations of the captain's role by signing, dating and submitting such form at the time of entering a team into a league during the entry period.



PLAY BEGINS: Wednesday, September 10 on College Park Courts. The captain is responsible for notifying his/her team of the playing schedule. Playing schedules will be available from the web site, or the captain may pick up a copy in the IM Office. We do not otherwise notify teams regarding playing schedules and eligible players. **(Each team must come to play with a good can of balls for each match.)**



ROSTER CHANGES: At anytime during the regular season of play captains will be allowed to make roster changes in the IM Office (in person) or at the contest site, limited to 2 player changes. New players must sign an "Agreement to Participate" form prior to playing.

PLAYOFFS: The captain is responsible for notifying his/her team of the playoff schedule. Playoff schedules will be available from the web site, or the captain may pick up a copy in the IM Office. We do not personally notify teams regarding playoff schedules. Teams must be able to play any day W-R, after 5:30 p.m. during playoffs.

ELIGIBILITY: 2008-09 Varsity and Club tennis players are ineligible to participate. Current year coaches and coaches and players from the previous academic year are eligible to play, but one total player is allowed per roster. Each player must come to play with a BGSU student picture ID. Faculty/staff need BGSU picture ID.
