

**Intramural Volleyball Employee Take-Home Rules Test - Spring 2009**

The purpose of having you complete this test **before** the volleyball clinic is to help you be more prepared for the clinic, and allow more time for on-court instruction. Please return this completed test to the Intramural Office by 12 noon on **Friday, February 27<sup>th</sup>**, so it can be graded before the clinic. Please take a copy of the rules to help with the test. The mandatory volleyball clinic will be held Sunday, March 1<sup>st</sup>, 7-10 p.m..

*Part I.* Write T if statement is true, F if the statement is false.

- \_\_\_\_\_ 1. If one or more player(s) is attempting to block and contacts the ball, this player is not eligible to participate in the next contact.
- \_\_\_\_\_ 2. A player may use any part of the body to play the ball.
- \_\_\_\_\_ 3. A player is not allowed to follow through over the net when executing a spike or block.
- \_\_\_\_\_ 4. The ball may never be played by the defensive team until the entire ball has crossed the top of the net.
- \_\_\_\_\_ 5. Whichever team reaches 23 points in a game first will be declared the winner.
- \_\_\_\_\_ 6. A server may not step/touch on or over the end line until the ball has been contacted on the serve.
- \_\_\_\_\_ 7. In co-rec, when a ball is returned over the net on the second hit (assume no block occurred), at least one of the contacts must have been by a female, and one of the contacts by a male.
- \_\_\_\_\_ 8. In co-rec, with six players on the court, male team members may exceed female team members.
- \_\_\_\_\_ 9. Players who cover their earrings with tape will be allowed to play.
- \_\_\_\_\_ 10. A co-rec team must use an alternate female/male line-up, but after service they may exchange positions as long as the back row players don't try to hit or block with the front row players.
- \_\_\_\_\_ 11. At the center line (under the net), a player may touch the other side of the court with their entire hand but not their entire foot.
- \_\_\_\_\_ 12. A ball contacting the basketball backboards over the court will result in a replay.
- \_\_\_\_\_ 13. A player on the receiving team can block a serve.
- \_\_\_\_\_ 14. Time outs are 1 minute.
- \_\_\_\_\_ 15. Two members of this year's varsity or club volleyball teams may play on an Intramural team.
- \_\_\_\_\_ 16. The losing team from game one will always serve first in the second game.
- \_\_\_\_\_ 17. A co-rec team may play with 3 females and 2 males.
- \_\_\_\_\_ 18. Back row players may block at the net.
- \_\_\_\_\_ 19. Bandannas tied with a knot may be worn during play.
- \_\_\_\_\_ 20. After the serve, back row players may switch to the front row, and are allowed to spike at the net.
- \_\_\_\_\_ 21. While playing the ball at the net, a setter who begins the point as a back row player, may contact a ball that is completely above the net, as long as the ball doesn't pass entirely over the net.
- \_\_\_\_\_ 22. All three games will be played, even if one team wins the first two.
- \_\_\_\_\_ 23. Teams may attempt to block the serve.
