Job Description for Members of the Greek Leadership Team

Members of the Greek Leadership Team Shall:

- Maintain a cumulative 2.80 grade point average.
- Attend weekly meetings on Tuesdays at 7:00 p.m. (BTSU 307).
- Attend the GLT transition retreat on Sunday, January 24 from 10:00 a.m. – 5:00 p.m. (BTSU 308).
- Participate in the GLT fall retreat and planning session, Friday, August 20 and Saturday, August 21.
- Help plan and facilitate the Emerging Leaders Retreat in November 2010.
- Serve as a facilitator for Greek Challenge (GC) in the fall and spring semesters.
- Assist with the planning and implementation of the August and January Leadership Retreats.
- Propose a session for Leadership Academy in February 2010.
- Create “Signature Programming” to be used to present for chapters and councils.
- Implement “mini-EL” experiences for chapters in the spring semester.
- Develop and present transition workshops for chapters and councils.
- Prepare transition materials to pass on to future members of GLT.
- Attend all Greek Affairs leadership programs (EL, GC, August & January Leadership Retreats).
- Fulfill any other responsibilities designated by Greek Affairs or as necessary.

Successful applicants will also demonstrate understanding and skills in the following areas:

<i>Communication</i>	verbal/written, patience, listening, facilitation
<i>Leadership</i>	role model, self-awareness, maturity
<i>Management</i>	planning, organized, project management, implementation
<i>Team Player</i>	colleague, collaborator, problem solving
<i>Flexibility</i>	adaptability, availability, positive attitude, creativity

Applicants must meet the following criteria for consideration:

1. Be an initiated member of a chapter in good standing with BGSU and Inter/National headquarters
2. Maintain a 2.80 cumulative grade point average
3. NOT serve as a chapter president or a council executive officer
4. Attend weekly meetings on Tuesdays at 7:00pm beginning Tuesday, February 2.
5. Be committed to planning, implementing and attending ALL of the following programs:
