Lists of the courses that meet the degree requirements may be obtained from the College Office.

FOR GRADUATION YOU WILL NEED

- 1. Minimum GPA of 2.0 in all PSYC courses
2. 14 hours of PSYC courses taken at BGSU
3. Minimum GPA 2.00
4. 122 credit hours minimum, and,
5. A major, and if required, a minor, specialization or emphasis
6. 40 credit hours at the 3000/4000 level
7. Completion of all degree requirements, including the BG Perspective Core
8. At least 30 credit hours of BGSU course work
9. An official audit completed during the junior year, on file in the College Office

Any substitution or waiver of courses required for your major program must originate in the department/school offering the major program and must be approved by the College Office.

To ensure a timely graduation, see a College Advisor during the semester prior to your intended graduation.

Remember to complete an Application for Graduation by the end of the second week of classes during the fall and spring semesters, or by the end of the first week of the summer semester. For the specific dates, check with the College office or the Office of Registration and Records. You may log onto MyBGSU to complete the on-line application. After the deadlines, you will need to complete an application in person in the College office.

Minor Requirements (1 of the following):

- (a) Minor in a second dept./college (see catalog)
(b) Cognate minor: 24 hours from at least 3 of the following fields: BIOL, CHEM, CS, ECON, MATH (NOT Math 2130, 2150, 2160), PHIL, PHYS, or SOC
(c) Individualized Planned Minor, developed in consultation with a Faculty Advisor.
(d) General Science Minor (see Undergraduate Catalog)
