**Prerequisites**

- Sophomore standing or consent of department
- Sophomore standing or consent of department
- No prerequisite

- ECON 200 or higher
- ECON 202 and ACCT 221

- ACCT 200 or 221; ECON 200 or 202; and BA 204. (concurrent registration in BA 204 permitted.)
- C or better in BA 204, FIN 304, and MKT 300

- Junior standing
- BA 204

**Other Requirements**

1. Students must earn a C or higher in all courses taken for the minor.
2. All courses completed for the minor must be taken for a letter grade.
3. All students must complete at least 15 credit hours toward the minor that are not counted in the student's major or specialization or another minor.
4. For non-business students, the total number of hours earned in College of Business Administration courses may not exceed 25 percent or 30 hours of the 122 needed for graduation, counting the major and the minor. (Note: six hours of STAT and nine hours of ECON are exempt from this limitation).

## Frequently Asked Questions About the Entrepreneurship Minor

### Who might be interested in this minor?

Students from business and other majors who have an interest in someday starting their own business and/or working for an entrepreneurial company.

### Are there any student organizations related to this minor?

### If a course is required for my major and also for the Entrepreneurship minor, do I have to take an additional course?

You must complete at least 15 credit hours toward the minor that are not counted in your major. Check with your major advisor to determine if additional courses will be necessary.

### What if I need to request a course substitution?

Course substitutions for the minor must be approved by Entrepreneurship Academic Programs.

### What if I don't have a prerequisite for a course?

Prerequisites for all courses must be met.

### Where do I enroll to have a minor in Entrepreneurship?

You enroll in the minor in the college office of your major. It is generally recommended that you check after a few weeks to make sure you are officially registered for the minor.
