

LIFETIME ACHIEVEMENT RECOGNITION

One of the recommendations from the constituent groups to the President was that we all do more to recognize the good work and dedication of our University faculty, classified and administrative staff.

Therefore, the Senate Executive Committee formed an Ad Hoc Committee consisting of the Provost, three Senate officers, two other Senate members, and one representative each from USG and GSS to formulate additional recognition's for faculty.

Below is one such recognition and its nominating criteria. Faculty are urged to nominate other faculty or themselves for this recognition. We hope that this recognition will bring to positive light the work of our colleagues. All nominations are due in the Faculty Senate Office by **Monday, March 10, 2008**. The recognition ceremony will take place at a faculty luncheon on **Tuesday, April 08, 2008** from 11:30-1:30 in the Bowen-Thompson Student Union McMaster Room (308).

Purpose

1. To recognize a senior faculty member and/or administrator with faculty rank for outstanding contributions to BGSU over a ten (10) year period or more.
2. To focus upon an individual whose teaching, scholarly work, service, and administrative skills have contributed significantly to the vitality of the BGSU community.

The Recognition

The recognition shall be an engraved plaque and a \$1,000.00 cash award.

Criteria

1. The individual should be widely acknowledged across campus for exceptional teaching, scholarly / creative work, service, and/or administrative skills insofar as these activities have made BGSU a more vital educational community for students, staff, faculty, and administrators.
2. The individual should have had at least ten (10) consecutive years as a faculty member and/or administrator with faculty rank at BGSU and have demonstrated significant contributions to the BGSU community for a sustained period of time.

Eligibility

Any full time, tenure track faculty member or administrator with faculty rank with at least ten (10) years of service at BGSU, excluding members of the selection committee are eligible.

Procedures

1. Any BGSU faculty member may make a nomination for this recognition.
2. The nominator should submit a letter of nomination (no more than 500 words); vita of the nominee (maximum of 10 pages), and three (no more than one page each) letters of support.
3. The selection committee for this award will be the Senate officers, a representative from the Office of the Provost, a representative from Graduate Student Senate, and a representative from Undergraduate Student Government.
