

## Graduate Assistantship Rates for Academic Year 2010-2011 and Summer 2011

In addition to receiving the contracted amount, students receive grants covering the Ohio Instructional, non-resident and general fees. The Graduate College pays all three of these fees for assistantships paid from its allocation. For assistantships paid from other sources, the Graduate College pays the instructional and non-resident fee, but the general fee is charged to the area/org paying the stipend.
