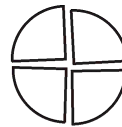


CNC MISSION AND INSPIRATION

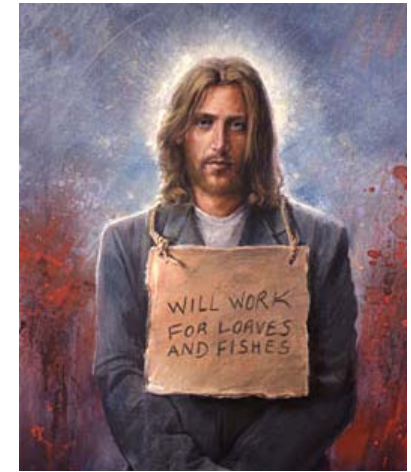
