

BOWLING GREEN STATE UNIVERSITY PROGRAM SPECIFIC TRANSFER AGREEMENT

The BGSU Program Specific Transfer Agreement has been designed to aid BGSU colleges/departments in building discipline/program specific articulation agreements with two-year institutions. This agreement documents a pathway from **Sinclair Community College: Associate of Arts in Music**, to **Bowling Green State University: Bachelor of Music (B.M.)**.

This agreement documents BG Perspective and major-specific course equivalencies that will transfer from **Sinclair Community College** to BGSU. The academic requirements contained in this agreement will be in effect beginning **Fall Semester 2020** and will be in effect until **the end of Spring semester 2023**. Both institutions agree to notify each other within 30 days of significant findings or changes in programmatic or institutional accreditation status.

I. Discipline/Program Specific Admission Requirements

In addition to BGSU admission requirements for transfer, <https://www.bgsu.edu/admissions/apply-now/transfer-students/transfer-admission-requirements.html> students must meet the following:

- **Must pass an entrance audition one semester prior to enrollment at BGSU.**
- **Must have a minimum 2.5 Cumulative GPA.**
- **Music Theory I-IV and Aural Skills I-IV will be transferred as their BGSU listed equivalents when transcripts show all eight courses (see page 3) passed with a grade of C or better at Sinclair Community College. Otherwise, a diagnostic examination in general musicianship will determine placement in Music Theory courses.**

II. University Requirements

Each student enrolled in a baccalaureate program must satisfactorily complete WRIT 1120 Academic Writing, one course approved for Cultural Diversity in the US, and one course approved for International Perspective. An international experience, defined as an academic study abroad experience bearing three or more credits or a documented international military deployment of at least 30 consecutive or 60 nonconsecutive days, also will fulfill the International Perspective requirement.

Please note that BGSU has a Foreign Language Admission Requirement; however, the foreign language admissions requirement does not apply to students who have completed 30 or more semester hours of credit-bearing post-secondary courses at BGSU Firelands or at another college or university.

III. General Education (BG Perspective) Equivalencies

All students must meet BGSU's university general education, college, and program-specific degree requirements effective at the time the student enters the BGSU program. All candidates for a baccalaureate degree at BGSU must complete at least **36 credit hours** from the BG Perspective curriculum, distributed as noted on page 2.

*In order for Music Theory I-IV and Aural Skills I-IV to be transferred as their BGSU listed Equivalents, all eight courses must be passed at SCC with a C or better.

§SCC Piano Majors have Voice as their minor instrument and complete the minor requirement by taking MUS 1119 (1 credit) four times.

*For all other SCC instrument Majors, including Vocal Majors, the minor instrument will be Piano, and students complete the requirement by taking MUS 1115, MUS 1116, MUS 2115 and MUS 2116 (all four courses, 1 credit each).
