CURRICULUM DEVELOPMENT

Use of Self as Agent of Change. Developed a new class for the BGSU doctoral program in Organizational Development and Change. This class integrated contemporary mindfulness-based behavior therapy theories and techniques with perspectives from the organizational development literature.

East-West Mindfulness/Personal Development Class. Partnering with Nattasuda Taephant, Ph.D. at Chulalongkorn University. We developed and co-teach an undergraduate class that provides students with Eastern and Western theories and techniques related to mindfulness and contextual behavioral science (primarily Acceptance and Commitment Therapy and Functional Analytic Psychotherapy).

East-West Contextual Behavioral Science Advanced Clinical Team and Seminar. Developed a scientist-practitioner clinical team and an advanced seminar that focuses on the integration of Western and Nonwestern perspectives in contextual behavioral science.

Graduate Training Program in Behavioral Medicine/Clinical Health Psychology. Designed, implemented, and coordinated the Behavioral Medicine Track for the APA-Approved Clinical Psychology Program at Bowling Green State University. Established training sites at area hospitals and medical clinics.

Undergraduate Psychophysiology Lab and Classes. Designed an undergraduate psychophysiology lab (EEG, ECG, EMG, BVPA, Resp, SCR) that is used for teaching. Developed an undergraduate course where students acquire basic skills in psychophysiological recording and hypothesis testing. Topics include: basic neuroscience, measurement principles, EEG, ECG, EMG, SCL, hypnosis/states of consciousness, lie detection, and biofeedback.

Graduate Clinical Research Methods. Developed this graduate level course in which students acquire knowledge and skills in clinical decision making, single subject design, between-group designs and meta-analysis. Students are encouraged to write high quality research papers and submit them to conferences and journals. Recent innovations in the class have focused on better understanding methodological limitations of WEIRD (Western, Educated, Industrial, Rich, Democratic) research..
