Effort and Resources



Easy. Can be done in your free time and with little planning in advance. Participation of Residence Hall Staff is needed. Volunteers are also welcome!

Objective and Overview

To educate residential communities on proper single-stream recycling. RA's, Hall Staff and volunteers go door-to-door in a residence hall and educate residents on the basics of recycling, its importance and how to avoid contamination.



How to Run the Program

Step 1: Establish Time, Staff and Make Announcement

Decide **which day and what time** the event will occur (7pm is ideal). Gather interested RA's, Hall Staff and any volunteers and disperse evenly amongst floors (ex. 3 per floor). **Make an announcement** prior to the event!

Step 2: Grab a Move-In Cart, Signs and Bags



A cart will help you to collect recycling and **bring recycling signs** with you to help visualize the information being given. **Bring bags** to collect their recycling as well! This event is about education, so generate conversation!

Step 3: Gather Recycling from Students and Educate Them!

Collect all recyclable items and inform residents using the signs. **Do not collect waste** or non-recyclable items. This event is about **spreading the correct information on recycling** to the residents in an efficient manner!
