Natural Dyes and Natural Homemade Paints

Natural Dyes

- 1/2 cup of plant material for desired color
- 1 cup of water
 - 1. Mix half a cup of plant material with one cup of water in a pan and bring to a boil.
 - 2. Simmer on low for half an hour, adding additional water as it evaporates.
 - 3. Mix colors together for different shades of color.

Natural Homemade Paints

- 1 cup of cornstarch
- 1/2 cup of water
- 1/3 cup of soap flakes melted with a half cup of boiling water
- Natural dyes
 - 1. Grate a soap bar until you get a third cup of soap flakes.
 - 2. Combine cornstarch, water, and melted soap in a bowl.
 - 3. Stir well and let mixture set until thickened.
 - 4. Divide into separate bowls and add in natural dyes for color.
 - 5. Your paints are now ready for paper.
