



The Falcon Tuition Guarantee

- Guaranteed Tuition Program for first time degree seeking undergraduate students on the BGSU Main Campus
- Guarantees the same rate for 4 years (12 consecutive semesters) and includes:
 - -Tuition (instructional & general fees)
 - -Out of state surcharge
 - -Housing & meals
 - -Special program fees
 - -Course & class fees

To Do Items:

- Financial Aid Authorization students can allow Federal Aid to cover expenses other than tuition, room and meals (i.e. parking permit, BG1 Card, etc.). Federal Aid can not cover monthly service charges or late fees
- Electronic 1098T Authorization





Refunds

- Paper checks are processed once a week and mailed to the student's home address
- e-Refunds/direct deposits are processed three times a week
- Refunds are released the first day of classes: plan accordingly!
- All Parent PLUS refunds not authorized to be released to a student are processed as a paper check and mailed to the parent

- If you are not 18, please contact the Student Insurance Office to request the waiver form



















Payment Details

 - -Fall and/or Spring; 4 payments; \$35 enrollment fee















Taking Care of Your Bill
