ITINERARY

DAY 1: MONTRÉAL, CANADA

Embark on your luxury cruise aboard the M/V *Victory II* in Montréal, Canada.

DAY 2: MONTRÉAL, CANADA

Enjoy a walking tour of the Old Montréal neighborhood, a blend of modern shops and historic sites such as the Notre-Dame Basilica. View the grand church's ornate decorations, including gorgeous stained-glass windows, before driving through the downtown business district to the top of Mount Royal for a panoramic view of the city and the Saint Lawrence River. Then, visit downtown's Botanical Gardens, one of the world's largest.

DAY 3–4: QUÉBEC CITY, CANADA

Visit the only walled city in North America. Board a motor coach, and travel to the Plains of Abraham, a large city park and scene of the Battle of Québec (1759). Continue to Place Royale, a small picturesque plaza, and then travel out of Québec City to Montmorency Falls where you'll take a cable ride offering incredible bird's-eye views.

DAY 5: SCENIC SAILING OF THOUSAND ISLANDS

Journey through the Thousand Islands, an archipelago of over 1800 islands rising up from the St. Lawrence River. These hauntingly beautiful fragments of land, lush with the vegetation of moss and maple trees, mark the border between the United States and Canada. Known for private mansions like the Boldt Castle—built by American millionaire George Boldt, owner of the Waldorf Astoria—Thousand Islands enchants visitors with its stately nineteenth century summer homes, a scattering of lighthouses, and an antique boat museum.

DAY 6: KINGSTON, CANADA

Visit Kingston, an ever changing city brimming with history and culture. Destroyed by fire in the 1840s, it was rebuilt from bricks and local limestone gaining the nickname "limestone city". Downtown is home to the Kingston Public Market, one of the oldest markets in Ontario, and a staple for the community since 1801. Kingston's historic waterfront is perched where the Cataraqui River, St. Lawrence River, and Lake Ontario meet; it is popular as a freshwater diving site, and host to Cork, the Freshwater Sailing Festival.

DAY 7: TORONTO, CANADA

Toronto, Ontario, is the most culturally diverse city on the planet with over 140 languages spoken. It is estimated that over half of Toronto's residents were born outside Canada, yet despite its complex makeup, it is a thriving, connected community. Toronto is a vibrant city abuzz with activity, and home to some of the world's finest restaurants, bars, clubs, and eclectic festivals.

DAY 8: NIAGARA FALLS / PORT COLBORNE, CANADA

Arrive at Port Colborne's entrance to the historic twenty-seven-mile-long Welland Canal. Board a state-of-the-art Hornblower cruise vessel and experience a thrilling up-close perspective of the famous Horseshoe Falls, with its breathtaking misty spray. Afterward, travel the scenic Niagara Parkway to Château des Charmes for a winery tour with lunch and wine tasting. After lunch, continue to Niagara-on-the-Lake to browse the town's shops and galleries.

DAY 9: CLEVELAND, OHIO

Celebrate music history at the Rock and Roll Hall of Fame—which supports community and culture through creative exhibits, programs, and festivals—and explore Cleveland's West Side Market, filled with the unique and diverse fares of over 100 vendors, and highlighted on television's Travel Channel and Food Network.

DAY 10: DETROIT, MICHIGAN

Disembark the M/V *Victory II* in Detroit.
