

Faculty Research Incentive Program

1. Research Publication Incentive

1.1. Incentive.

1.1.a. Articles published in a journal rated 4 on College of Business Journal List (CoBJL) will receive [\$7,500]. Articles published in a journal rated 3 on CoBJL will receive [\$5,000]. Articles published in a journal rated 2 on CoBJL will receive [\$2,500]. Articles published in a journal rated 1 on CoBJL will receive [\$1,000]. Any portion of the award may be used as salary enhancement or distributed to the faculty's professional development account. The actual amount awarded each year may vary and will depend on College's budget and the total number of publications eligible for the incentive program.

1.1.b. For 3- or 4-rated publications, the College of Business faculty member(s) will each receive the full award amount, regardless of the number of authors. For 1- or 2-rated publications, the following applied: for publications with no more than three authors, the College of Business faculty member(s) each will receive the full award amount. For publication with four authors, the College of Business faculty member(s) each will receive 75% of the full award amount. For publication with five or more authors, the College of Business faculty member(s) each will receive 50% of the full award amount. The number of authors excludes master and undergraduate students.

1.2. Eligibility. All faculty who are AACSB qualified on August 1, 2017 are eligible.

1.3. Approved Journal List. The CoBJL will be finalized in Fall 2017. Faculty may petition for journal inclusion for publications which have final acceptance date after August 1, 2017 but prior to the date when the Incentive Program is approved. The guideline for journal inclusion petition can be found in Journal Impact Determination and Review Policy.

1.4. Time Period. The incentive program applies to publication which has final acceptance date occurring during the period August 1, 2017 - July 31, 2018.
