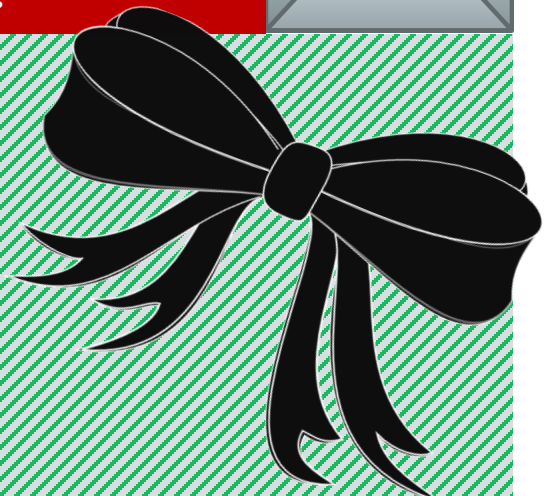


By switching to hand-dipped beeswax candles you will help to reduce the amount of petroleum-based candles produced each year!
