Green Roofs are rooftops covered with a garden of plants!

Benefits of Green Roofs:

- Urban Heat Island Mitigation—planting gardens on roofs causes the plants to absorb the sun's heat, lowering the temperature of urban environments
- **HVAC Savings**—green roofs provide great insulation saving money on heating and cooling costs
- Habitat Creation—plants attract butterflies, birds, and other wildlife to urban settings
- Extension of Roof Life—green roofs last 300% longer than conventional roofs
