Aluminum

Recycling two aluminum cans saves the amount of energy it takes to power a PC for one workday.

Plastics

One recycled bottle saves enough energy to run a 100-watt bulb for four hours.



Paper

The average college student produces 640 pounds of solid waste each year, including 500 disposable cups and 320 pounds of paper.

Meat

The amount of water used to produce 1 lb of beef is approximately 2500 gallons, equivalent to the amount of water used in a 7 minute shower every day for 6 months

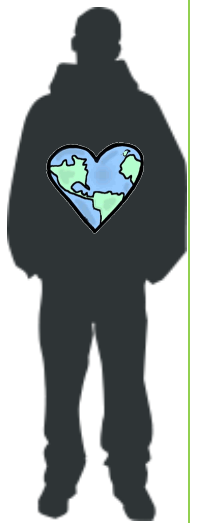
