RE: Exterior Illumination Upgrade

Dear Benjamin & Matt:

Thank you for your proposal requesting funds from the Student Green Initiatives Fund for the proposed exterior illumination upgrade project. The proposal requested a total amount of \$1,068,050 for the project. This project is broken into four phases; this award letter will focus on phase one with a cost of \$254,150.

As is the policy of the Green Fund Committee, the application was reviewed and discussed at the meeting held on Friday, April 28, 2017. The Committee viewed the project as consistent with the sustainability goals of BGSU. Specifically, it is aimed at reducing greenhouse gas emissions, which is a component of our Climate Action Plan as a requirement of the American Colleges & Universities President's Climate Commitment.

The Committee voted to approve the first phase of the proposal, granting the requested amount of \$254,150 towards upgrading the outdoor lighting in old campus to LED's, with the following provisos:

1. The Student Green Fund Initiative would receive the Efficiency Smart Award funds
2. Signage in old campus would be required as an educational tool outlining the benefits of LED's
3. The award would exclude any new LED lighting on the perimeter of University and Mosely Hall that has already been incorporated into the renovations
4. Operations will pay the engineering fees for the project.
5. The University must take financial leadership on future phases of the LED Project to move toward Carbon Neutrality

Should you, and the rest of Campus Operations agree to these terms, please have the appropriate parties sign below and return to Fund Administrator, Dr. Nicholas Hennessy's office for dispersal of funds. If you have any questions on the details of this letter, please contact him as well.
