## REMINDERS

- (1) HDFS 2020 is a required course and can be used as a social and behavioral science elective.
- (2) FN 2070 is a required course and can be used as a natural science.
- (3) Meet with your advisor at least once each year. The name of your advisor appears in the MyBGSU web page, click on "My Advisor"
- (4) SENIOR YEAR: You must apply for graduation online prior to the term deadline; complete applications for licensure during your student teaching semester (you will receive instructions for doing so during a required meeting that precedes student teaching).
- (5) Remember you must have passed all state required assessments and other state requirements to be issued a teaching license by the state.
- (6) Complete at least 30 hours of coursework at BGSU.
- (7) For the MyBGSU web page, click on "My Degree Audit" link to access your degree audit.

NOTE: Undergraduate students and degree holders seeking licensure must meet all specified requirements, including successful completion of all state required assessments to qualify for the Family and Consumer Sciences licensure.
