REMINDERS

- (1) HDFS 2020 is a required course and can be used as a social and behavioral science elective.
- (2) FN 2070 is a required course and can be used as a natural science.
- (3) Meet with your advisor at least once each year. The name of your advisor appears in the MyBGSU web page, click on "My Advisor"
- (4) SENIOR YEAR: You must apply for graduation online prior to the term deadline; complete applications for licensure during your student teaching semester (you will receive instructions for doing so during a required meeting that precedes student teaching).
- (5) Eligibility for Professional Year Internship: A passing score on all required Ohio Assessments for Educators (OAE) as determined each year by the Department of Education is required to be eligible for the Professional Year Internship (student teaching). (Note: OAE test requirements are subject to change, so continue to check with your program and the Ohio Department of Education for updates).
- (6) Complete at least 30 hours of coursework at BGSU.
- (7) For the MyBGSU web page, click on "My Degree Audit" link to access your degree audit.

NOTE: Undergraduate students and degree holders seeking licensure must meet all specified requirements, including successful completion of all state required assessments to qualify for the Family and Consumer Sciences licensure.
