- Freshman & Sophomore Years:**
- a. Prioritize coursework & studying.
 - b. Complete 1000 & 2000-level classes, along
with major content courses. These are
prereqs for other courses you'll need.
 - c. Ed Psych is a prereq for program admis
sion, EDTL 3400, and several upper
level classes.
- You are a pre-major in AYA education until you
meet criteria for Program Admission:**
- 3.0 cumulative GPA
 - Completion of GSW 1120, Year 1 block
courses, EDTL 2020, EDFI 3030, & EDIS 2310
with a "C" or better.
 - Writing sample
 - Dispositions check
 - Possible interview
- You may apply again later if not admitted.
- Junior Year: You will need a 3.0 cumulative GPA
and 2.8 concentration-area GPAs to enroll in EDTL
3400.**
- a. You must also have taken all course
prerequisites and completed them with a
grade of "C" or better.
- Senior Year: Both Methods and Student Teaching
require 3.0 cumulative and 2.8 concentration-area
GPAs.** See eligibility requirements at left.
- Transfer students** must complete 15 semester hours
at BGSU prior to program admission.
