- The LDT Program requires a 36-hour cognate (area of applied, technical courses), which typically is transferred from an accredited associate degree. Combined, these technical and/or applied courses must demonstrate proficiency in a recognized, technical area. In the event that there are fewer than 36 hours to complete a cognate, an LDT advisor will approve courses to fulfill his requirement.
- A minimum of 40 hours of credit must be at the 3000 or 4000 level.
