

Associate of Arts Group Requirements

Communication

Each student is required to acquire proficiency in written expression. GSW 1120 is required. Based on English placement tests, GSW 1100 or 1110 may also be required. The Office of Student Services will provide placement information before the first semester. As a result of placement a student may be required to take a total of 11 credit hours of writing. However, no more than six hours of basic writing can be applied toward graduation. Each student should also acquire proficiency in oral communication; a COMM or other oral communication course is strongly recommended.

Mathematics and Science (3 courses min)

Two courses must be selected from the Natural Sciences BG Perspective curriculum and one course must be a Quantitative Literacy course (see front).

Social and Behavioral Sciences (2 courses min)

Two courses must be selected from the social and behavioral science BG Perspective curriculum

Humanities and Arts (2 courses min)

Two courses must be selected from the humanities and arts BG Perspective curriculum.

Cultural Diversity (1 course min)

International Perspectives (1 course min)

SI, HI, or Academic Study Abroad of at least 3 hours
