### NOTES:

- Students must meet all course requirements in effect at the time of enrollment.
- Students must earn a letter grade of C or better in all courses taken for the minor.

All students must complete at least 15 credit hours toward the minor that are not counted in the student's major or specialization or another minor. Course substitutions for the minor must be approved by the College of Business Administration.

The total number of hours earned in College of Business Administration courses may not exceed 25 percent or 30 hours of the 122 needed for graduation, counting the major and minor (six hours of STAT and nine hours of ECON are exempt from this limitation).
