For students planning on pursuing the Bachelor of Science Advanced Technological Education degree program, a minimum of 36 hours are required for the technical concentration. Where choices exist, courses marked \* are required.

Courses marked ^ are general education courses. With careful selection, they may be applied to general education requirements of a bachelor's degree.

Each student must complete a sufficient number of electives to earn a minimum of 62 semester hours. At least 15 credit hours must be BGSU courses. Please check with your advisor for appropriate course selections.
