You must complete an official junior audit with a college advisor during your **junior** year [60-89 hours]. To do so, you must schedule an appointment with a college advisor. You should bring a completed copy of this check sheet and a current copy of your Degree Audit Reporting System (DARS) report. A college advisor will provide you with a detailed form that specifies your remaining requirements for graduation.

FOR GRADUATING WITH A BFA ART EDUCATION THREE-DIMENSIONAL STUDIES DEGREE YOU WILL NEED:

1. Completion of all specified Art Education and Education requirements
2. A minimum of 129-143 credit hours

PREREQUISITES FOR TEACHING INTERNSHIP

1. A "C" or better in GSW 1120, COMM 1020, AND EDTL 2010
2. Completion of all ARTE courses (2520, 3520, 3820, 4070, and 4520)
3. A 2.5 minimum accumulative GPA

NOTE: If you are unable to maintain a 2.5 GPA as you progress through the program, you **MUST** see your advisor who will assist you in seeking alternative degree programs.

MINIMUM UNIVERSITY REQUIREMENTS NEEDED FOR GRADUATION WITHOUT LICENSURE

1. Minimum GPA 2.00
2. 122 credit hours minimum,
3. A major, and if required, a minor, specialization or emphasis
4. 40 credit hours at the 3000/4000 level
5. Completion of all degree requirements, including the BG Perspective Core
6. At least 30 credit hours of BGSU course work
7. An official audit completed during the junior year, on file in the College Office

Any substitution or waiver of courses required for your major program **must** originate in the department/school offering the major program and **must** be approved by the College Office.

To ensure a timely graduation, see a **College Advisor** during the semester prior to your intended graduation.

Remember to complete an **Application for Graduation** by the end of the second week of classes during the fall and spring semesters, or by the end of the first week of the summer semester. For the specific dates, check with the College office or the Office of Registration and Records. You may log onto MyBGSU to complete the on-line application. After the deadlines, you will need to complete an application in person in the College office.
