ELECTIVES

Criteria for Acceptance into the Dance Major

1. Completion of 30 semester hours (any university courses) including: "C" or better in GSW 1120, COMM 1020, DANC 1150, DANC 1200, DANC 1500, and DANC 3260.
2. University GPA (from DARS audit) of 2.5 or higher.
3. Formal application completed by student, signed by advisor, and approved by the Dance program (109 Eppler Center).
4. Satisfactory ranking in technique/performance audition into Dance Program.

SENIOR YEAR: You must apply for graduation on-line prior to the term deadline. You also must complete at least 30 hours of coursework at BGSU.
