II. ELIGIBILITY FOR INSTRUCTIONAL METHODS

- _____ Possess a 2.75 accumulative GPA.
- _____ Completion of the following courses with a grade of "C" or better: EDIS 2310, 4110, 4120, 4210, 4220, 4230, 4240, 4250, 4450, 4460; Math 2130/2150.
- _____ Satisfactory completion of all program courses except EDIS 4400, 4410, 4420, 4470, 4920.
- _____ Methods sign-up information can be obtained at a methods meeting the semester prior to your methods coursework.
- _____ Transfer students must complete at least 15 hours at BGSU prior to program admission.
- _____ Completion of EDIS 3100 and 4100 with an "S".

III. ELIGIBILITY FOR TEACHING INTERNSHIP

- _____ Full acceptance into EDIS program (this includes "C" or better in GSW 1120, COMM 1020, and EDHD 2010) and satisfactory performance in course-related field and clinical experiences.
- _____ 90 semester hours of college credit.
- _____ Completion of EDFI 3020 or 3030 ("C" or better).
- _____ EDIS 4400, 4410, 4420, 4450, 4460, 4470 ("C" or better).
- _____ Application for teaching internship is made at a sign-up meeting held the second Wednesday of each semester for students planning to do their teaching internship the following semester.
- _____ Possess an accumulative grade point average of 2.75.

Eligibility for teaching internship can be revoked for reasons such as basic skills deficiency, poor interpersonal communication, and unprofessional behavior by the written recommendation of two or more SIS faculty members, supported by the School Appeals Committee.

REMINDERS:

- (1) PSYC 1010 is a pre-requisite to PSYC 3030, 3040, EDFI 3020, and EDFI 3030 and can be used as a social science elective; EDFI 4080 is a required education course and can also be used to fulfill the Cultural Diversity elective.
- (2) Meet with your advisor at least once each year. Names of advisors and other assistance can be obtained via MyBGSU web page, click on "My Advisor."
- (3) SENIOR YEAR: You must apply for graduation on-line prior to the term deadline; complete an application for licensure during your student teaching internship semester--you will receive instructions for doing so during a required meeting that precedes the teaching internship.
- (4) Remember that you must have a 2.5 accumulative grade point average and have successfully completed the Praxis II Tests to be eligible for provisional licensure upon graduation.
- (5) Teaching internship in the specific program area may not be taken more than twice without the permission of the School Appeals Committee.
- (6) You must complete at least 30 hours of coursework at BGSU.
