

Transition into Adulthood Study (TA) A Panel Study of Income Dynamics (PSID) Supplement

Data Notes

1 Sample Description

The "Transition into Adulthood Study" (TA) began in 2005. It was designed to collect data on all children included in the Child Development Supplements who had turned 18, finished high school, and whose families were still participating in the PSID. The TA collects data addressing developmental pathways in the period between early childhood, mid childhood, adolescence (collected in the Child Development Supplements I-III) and adulthood (once the respondent becomes the household head for the core PSID). The second wave of the TA (collected in 2007), consists of 1,118 individuals with a 90% response rate. The codebook for the third wave of data, collected in 2009, is expected to be released in February of 2012.
