- **1** This question is preceded by a question that was not publicly released, so the small number of respondents who were skipped or not asked this question cannot be accounted for.
- **2** Question m4f3a1_5 refers to children of respondents who are living apart from them. Respondents who answer "Yes" to question m4f3 ("Do you have any children living apart from you?") are asked follow-up questions about their children's living arrangements.
