Grandmother The female parent of the child's biological or adoptive mother or father. Grandfather The male parent of the child's biological or adoptive mother or father. Uncle The brother of the child's biological or adoptive mother or father or the husband of the child's aunt. Cousin A child of the focal child's uncle, aunt, or cousin. Other relative Refers to relationships that aren't specifically listed, such as great grandmother, niece, or nephew. Other non-relative Refers to the relationship between two people when there is no family relationship through blood, marriage, adoption, or partnership (i.e., living together as married). It also refers to more ambiguous relationships that exist where there are two people living together as married and they have children.
