Religion & Spirituality Variable Notes

- 1 The variable RELIGION was recoded from the variable RELCURR, with responses being collapsed.
- 2 This question was asked in the questionnaire, but an exact corresponding variable (and subsequent unweighted frequencies) is unavailable in the public-use data file.
 - Information from this question was used to generate constructed variables on religion.
- 3 A female pregnancy file was also compiled, consisting of one record per pregnancy for all female respondents having experienced pregnancy.
