CRESTED GECKO HABITAT

- Choose a habitat that is of an appropriate size for the animal and the number of animals you are using.
- This set up will be housing 3 adult crested geckos.
- Add a layer of paper towels to create easy to clean substrate.



Place a hide to give the animals a retreat.

- Add a tub filled with moss.
- Keep the moss moist but not soaked.
- Use of the bark is to add an additional hide





Because this habitat is housing more than one animal; multiple feeding locations are added to reduce competition.

- Place a water dish of an appropriate size.
- For crested geckos, a dish is added to hold a bottle cap containing the food.
- We use Pangea powdered mix.





- Optional: Add lighting and some extra foliage to give additional hiding locations as well to make it more eye appealing.
- And the final step is to add the geckos!
