

### **What are some of the basic commands in STATA?**

The logical expressions in STATA are pretty straightforward. In SAS you would use the word 'and' to indicate two or more conditions-in STATA you would use the symbol & .

To select and OR condition you need to use the symbol | (the straight line on the forward slash key).

STATA also doesn't like 'ge' or 'le' as in SAS, instead use < or > .

You need a double equals ( == ) to indicate equality. In STATA a single (=) is used for assignment, and the double (==) is used for equality.
