2009 New Year's Day Population Estimates from the U.S. Census Bureau

- The U.S. Census Bureau projects the Jan. 1, 2009 total U.S. population will be 305,529,237 -- up 2,743,429, or 0.9 percent, from New Year's Day 2008.
- In January 2009, one birth is expected to occur every eight seconds in the U.S. and one death every 12 seconds.
- Net international migration is expected to add one person every 36 seconds to the U.S. population in January 2009, resulting in an increase in the total U.S. population of one person every 14 seconds.
