### **Now Available from ICPSR...**

- **The American Time Use Survey** - ATUS collects information on how people living in the U.S. spend their time. Data collected in this study measure the amount of time that people spent doing various activities in 2008, such as paid work, child care, religious activities, volunteering, and socializing. Respondents were interviewed only once about how they spent their time on the previous day, where they were, and whom they were with. For more information please visit:

  - **The National Survey on Drug Use and Health (NSDUH)** - Formerly titled National Household Survey on Drug Abuse, this survey primarily measures the prevalence and correlates of drug use in the U.S. Information is provided on the use of illicit drugs, alcohol, and tobacco among members of U.S. households aged 12 and older.
